
Lastly, the team that won the final set, ie, Arpan Yadav and Sumant Kumar were declared the winners.

A self-designed sample by the student expert was taken into account to explain the basic features of the design tool.



Manjinder Singh Sirsa (National Secretary of BJP) Under the guidance of Dr. Seema Singh, Convener of the D'Lang Chaps, Four students from Guru Teg Bahadur Institute of Technology (GTBIT), Gurmehar Singh Kalra, Amadhya Vats, Hargun Singh Narang and Ishmehar Kaur took part in an interactive discussion hosted by S. Manjinder Singh Sirsa, the National Secretary of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) on April 2, 2024. The agenda for the discussion was to give suggestions for the election manifesto of the BJP. Under the vision of #ViksitBharat of PM Shri Narendra Modi Ji. Implementing strategies like offering support resources and promoting wellness practices can help mitigate student stress and anxiety in academia. Ishmehar Kaur's suggestion aims to address the availability of seats for the general category in college admissions. This issue requires a nuanced approach, considering the existing reservation policies and the demand for education in various fields.

The journalists from ABP and ANI News interviewed Sirsa Ji about the BJP's manifesto and discussed students' expectations for educational changes, boosting morale. Journalists asked students about the suggestions they gave to Sirsa ji.
