The event's highlight, the Mr. and Ms. Personality contest, comprised three rounds designed to identify the show's heroes.

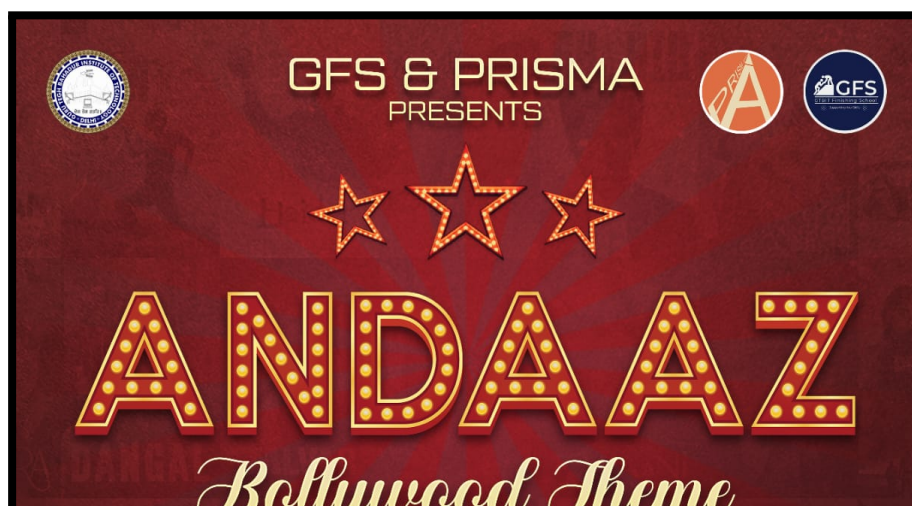
1. **Introduction Round:** Contestants had a minute to introduce themselves to the audience and judges, sharing their name, age, and unique attributes.

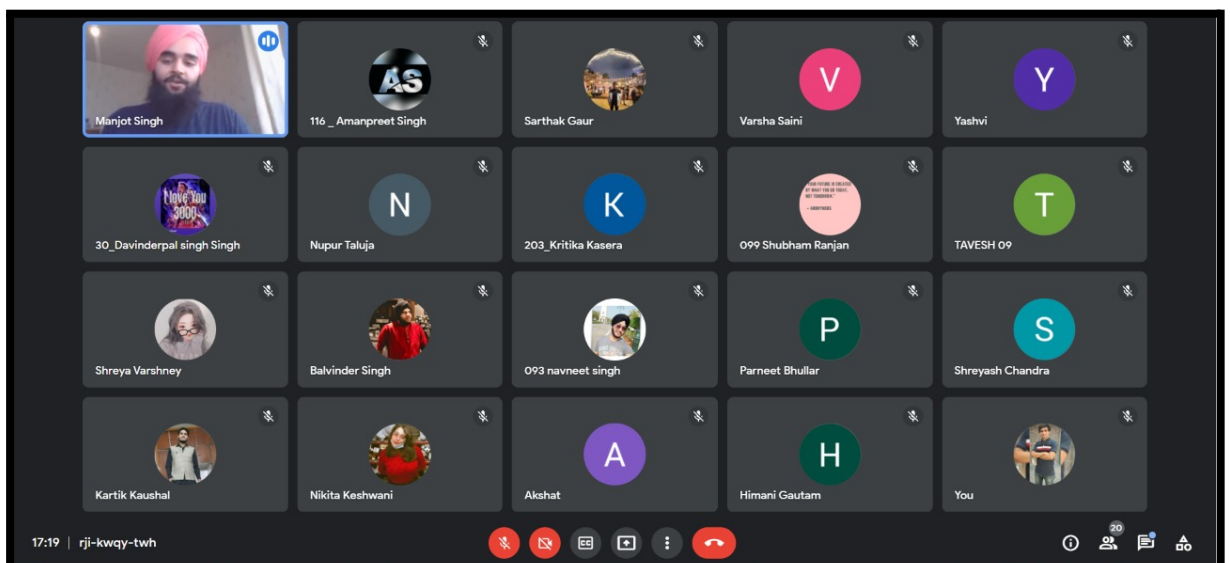
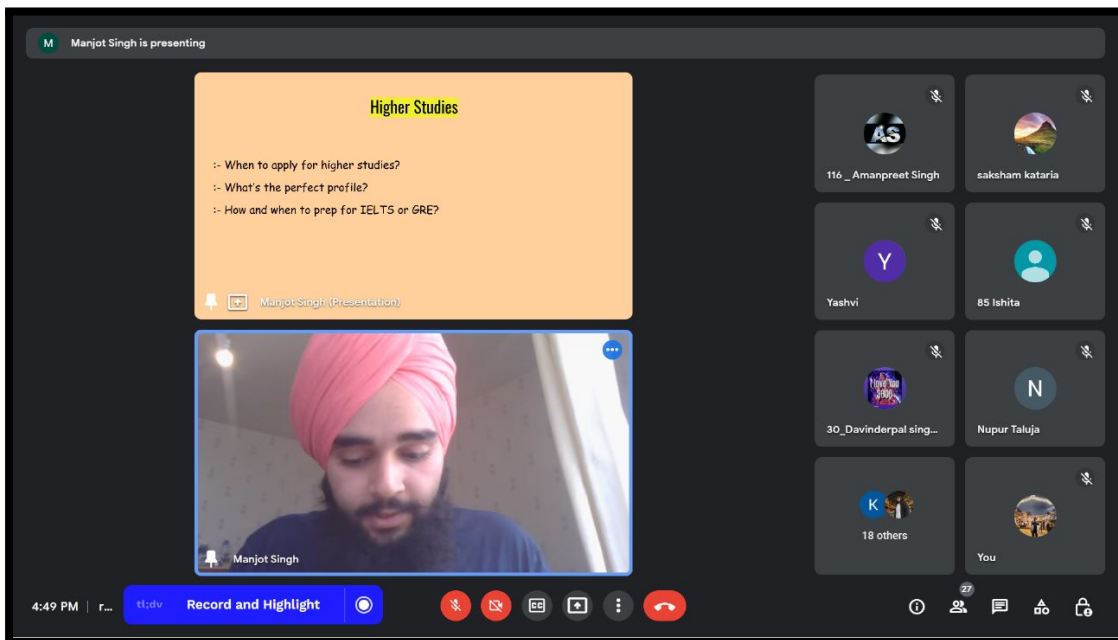
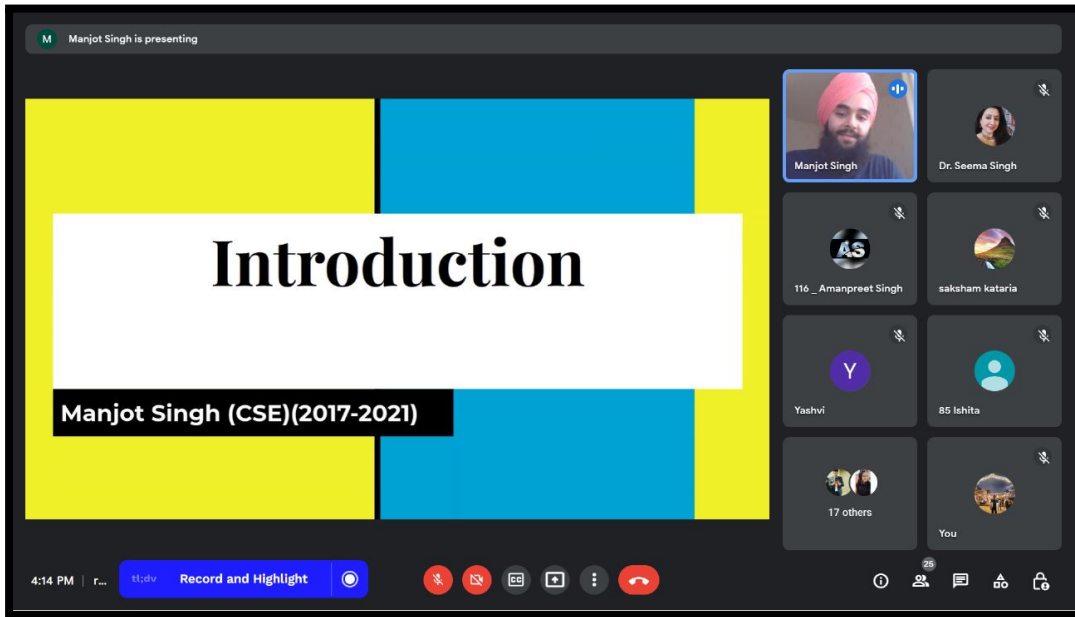
Key Insights:
