



Ms. Aditi provided strategies for managing interview nerves and building confidence before and during the interview process.

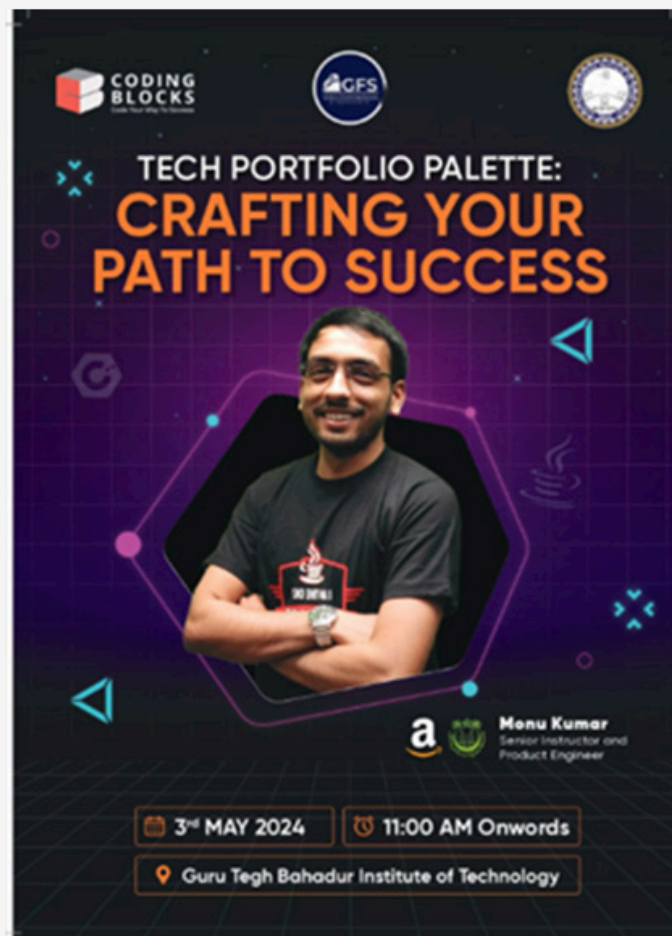
### Conclusion:

# Election Manifesto Discussion with the BJP National Secretary by GTBIT Students

2nd April 2024



Under the leadership and guidance of the Convenor of GTBIT Finishing School (GFS), Dr. Seema Singh, three students from Guru Teg Bahadur Institute of Technology (GTBIT), Mansi Bishnoi, Himani Gautam, and Ishmehar Kohli, took part in a major election manifesto discussion with S. Manjinder Singh Sirsa, the National Secretary of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) on April 2, 2024. Students from a number of colleges, including Mata Sundri College, Khalsa College and other prestigious institutions under Delhi University, were also invited for the discussion at Mr. Sirsa's office at 172 North Avenue.

Students made thoughtful recommendations on a wide range of subjects that were important to the modern job and educational environment. One important topic of conversation was the necessity of giving college students greater real-world experience. Students emphasized the value of experiential learning and suggested a curriculum that incorporates real-world applications to better prepare students for the challenges of the workforce.

Moreover, a lot of attention needed to be paid to the introduction of Artificial Intelligence (AI) education in schools. In order to give students the abilities they would need for the future, participants argued for the inclusion of AI technology in educational systems, recognising its increasing influence.

Furthermore, the students highlighted the significance of including regional history in academic syllabus, stressed the need for unemployment insurance so that people had a safety net in times of financial hardship and the need for government-sponsored jobs and internships.

The event's significance was further boosted by the presence of journalists from ANI and other news channels, who interviewed students and captured the conversations. Their coverage made sure that the viewpoints of the students were shared more widely, which further increased the influence of the discourse. Following a lively one on one, half an hour session, S. Manjinder Singh Sirsa captured a moment of unity with the participating students by taking pictures, signifying the sharing of ideas between the younger generation and the political leadership.

The discussion around the election manifesto demonstrated the proactive involvement of GTBIT students, under the able guidance of Dr. Seema Singh and an attempt to influence the country's socio-political dialogue. Their involvement emphasized how crucial it was for young people to have a say in shaping public policy and promoting inclusive governance.
